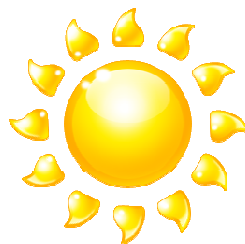
From Your Fleet Captain the infamous James H. Limbright...

Finally don't forget that the Detroit Boat Show is going to be February 12-20<sup>th</sup> at Cobo Hall in Detroit.

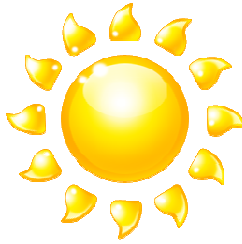
